Students represent themselves and RIS outside of school and are expected to maintain high standards whenever and wherever the uniform is worn, including travelling to and from school. Students have a responsibility to comply with this Uniform Policy. The Deputy Head(s), and the Heads of the School through the Homeroom Teachers/Form Tutors, are responsible for monitoring uniform and intervening should that prove necessary.

Breaches of Uniform Policy

Make up and fashion jewellery are not considered acceptable or appropriate for school. Haircuts and styles should not be extreme and should conform to the Health and Safety requirements of practical lessons. Students are not permitted to have any markings or tramlines shaved into their hair cut. No extreme haircuts are permitted. Any changes to hair colour should be of a natural shade and distributed in a natural manner. If in doubt, please consult The Deputy Head(s) or Head of School, before committing to a specific hair cut style. Failure to adhere to this policy may result in a student not being allowed in class or potentially sent home.

Purchasing and Replacing School Uniform

Please ensure that all uniform items are purchased exclusively from Zaks to maintain consistency. Substitute items are not permitted. All clothing and equipment should be clearly labelled with the student's name and form group. It is the responsibility of both students and parents to ensure that the student arrives at school each day in full uniform. Students that do not come to school in the correct uniform risk being sent home, or withdrawn from lessons until correct uniform is worn.

In the event that any uniform item becomes damaged or discolored, we kindly request that it be promptly replaced. Students should also be mindful that the same uniform standards apply when they are wearing the RIS uniform outside of school. We ask for parental support in helping students meet these expectations.
